NO GARBAGE/RECYCLING COLLECTION (shown in red), operating on a 1-day delay: Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas Day.

PLEASE RECYCLE THESE ITEMS:

- Milk & Juice Cartons, & Juice Boxes
- Plastics 1-5 & 7 (NO #6, Styrofoam, bags, or wrap)
- Wide-Mouth Plastic Containers & Lids
- Rigid Plastic Containers & Small Hard Plastic Toys
- Empty Aerosol Cans (NO paint cans)
- Aluminum Cans
- Metal Food Cans & Lids
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Cardboard Boxes 3' x 3' Flattened (including pizza boxes)
- Mixed Paper, Newspapers with Inserts, & Junk Mail
- Paperback Books
- Magazines & Phonebooks
- Spiral Paper Cans (with plastic lids detached)

WHAT YOU DO MATTERS!

- REDUCE** the amount of waste you produce
- REUSE** items or give them away
- RECYCLE** as much as possible

Recycling is collected every other week (shown in green) on your regularly scheduled garbage day.

PICKUP INFORMATION

- Collection of recycling is the same day as your garbage collection, but picked up every other week. Your recycling cart is green.
- Garbage is picked up every week.
- Yard waste dimensions must be no longer than 4 feet in length and no more than 5 inches in diameter.
- Bulk pickup – call Republic Services to schedule.

CART PLACEMENT

- Place carts with wheels facing your home.
- Keep carts 3 feet from one another and 3 feet from parked cars, mailboxes, etc.
- Do not block sidewalks with carts.
- Rinse out all cans, bottles, and jars.
- Do not bag recyclables.
